- Bold** notation denotes **MANDATORY** classes. Failure to attend **MANDATORY** classes can result in removal from class with no **REFUNDS**.
- Any **SAT** classes could be held at another location, directions will be provided.
- At each Written/Practical EXAM, students will be required to show the exam coordinator a pictured ID. All written **EXAMS** must be taken on the day offered; failure to attend these **Mandatory** Session will result in a 0 grade.
- Students must have paid all fees due, by the third CLASS. After the third class the student is responsible for all class fees.
- Students maybe offered the opportunity to purchase “**PASS EMT-B**” videotape (if available), by Mosby publishing, at the price to purchase or reproduce this tape, if purchased from a supplier cost will be plus tax and shipping & handling (approx. \$35).
- Attendance at all sessions is encouraged. Material missed can NOT be recovered by staff or instructors. If any student misses more than 4 sessions or 3 sessions in a row the student can be classified an incomplete and be removed from class with no **REFUNDS**.
- MANDATORY SESSIONS:** Milford Hospital Emergency Room observation time (10 hours, our sponsor hospital), (State Practical) must be completed no later the 3 weeks prior to the ending of class. Also attending the Extrication class and volunteering as a victim at the State of Connecticut Practical Exam process (held at Vinal Technical School in Middletown). Failure to complete these sessions the student can be classified as incomplete and can be removed from class with no **REFUNDS**.
- A valid CPR card is required to qualify to take the State EMT Exam and a copy must be provided at the last class session.
- Students will be considered successfully completing the class, with a FINAL grade-point-average of at least **70**, pass the FINAL Practical with **NO** more than a **1** station failure, and pass the FINAL Written Exam with a score of at least **70**, **NO** retakes or rescheduling of any exams will be offered.
