Also a general review of other skills and information needed everyday to be part of the Emergency Medical Services Field. Also included is an American Heart Association CPR Card – (Healthcare Provider Level), if desired.
Upon successful completion of the course students will be required to pay an additional fees, to the State of Connecticut, to qualify to take the DPH/EMS administrated Practical Exam and National Registry of EMTs Written Exam.

From I95:
To exit 34, at the bottom of the exit ramp go right onto Route 1, Bridgeport Avenue. Go approximately 1 mile to Naugatuck Avenue, turn left.
